

Membership Q&A

Q: I'm a former member of the Sequoyah Marching Band of Chiefs, but did not graduate from SHS. Am I eligible for membership into the Sequoyah Alumni Band Association?

A: Absolutely. If you are a former member of the "Band of Chiefs" or any of the SHS Bands (symphonic, jazz band, etc.), then you are eligible for regular membership. It matters not whether you are a graduate of SHS, you are entitled to all rights and privileges of a regular member of the Sequoyah Alumni Band Association.

Q: I used to march in the " Band of Chiefs ", but I don't know if I am ready/able to be financially support the Alumni Association. What should I do?

A: Fill out the Registration Form, and we'll make sure we keep you in the loop about our activities.

Q: What do I need to do to become a financial member?

A: Simply fill out the registration form, and send in your check or money order to our treasurer's address on the form. You will receive a 'Thank You' letter from the Association, as well as your membership credentials (certificate and card).
