

Concession Policy Statement

To: All Concession volunteers

The Band Booster officers would like to thank each and every one of the Concession Stand volunteers for your efforts in helping the band booster fund raising efforts.

In order to ensure everyone's safety in and around the concession stand, we ask that all volunteers adhere to the following safety policies.

1. No children are allowed in the concession stand during operation or during setup or cleanup.
2. No children are allowed inside the designated restricted area as identified on the concession stand setup diagram due to potential hazards, including but not limited to, hot grill (burns) and hot frying oil (burns) and Boiling water (burns).
3. Volunteers handling money or other non-food items are not allowed to handle food at the same time.
4. Food handling gloves must be worn by all volunteers handling non-packaged food items.
5. All volunteers must be aware of the location of the fire extinguishers that exist in the concession stand and the proper use of the fire extinguishers.

In addition to the safety policies, all volunteers must be aware of the following policies regarding concession stand menu items.

1. Volunteers scheduled to work in the concession stand for a specific game and in a specific position are welcome to have up to two beverage items at no cost.
2. Additional beverage items or any food item can be purchased by all concession stand volunteers at half price.
3. Half price purchases are only approved for scheduled concession stand volunteers. All others must pay the full menu price. Please see the concession co-chair for a list of scheduled volunteers.
4. No volunteer is authorized to remove any equipment, items or proceeds from the concession stand without permission of the Band Booster officers.
