

Member in Good Standing

Many students enjoy one or more areas of Sequoyah's Fine Arts Electives; Music, Visual Art, and Drama. Participation in the Instrumental Music Program; Marching Band, Symphony Band, Symphonic Band, String Orchestra, and one or more of many ensembles like steel drum band, percussion ensemble, etc. requires a time commitment as well as enrollment in the class.

Students wishing to participate in additional ensembles offered through the local colleges and other arts institutions are encouraged to do. Many of these 'audition only' groups **require** that a student be a "member on good standing" in their own local school music program. In order for the director to sign off and/or vouch for a student at Sequoyah as a "member in good standing" they must meet the following criteria:

- Be enrolled in an instrumental class for credit.
- Meet all participation and attendance requirements.
- Be on track for Lettering for that specific year.
- Meet their financial commitment (including grant requests).

If a student is not enrolled in the class they can remain in good standing by fulfilling the following requirements:

- Maintain active and consistent attendance **and** participation through lunch participation in class activities.
- Participate in all concert/performance opportunities (due to "Early Exit" to college or jobsite placement a student can only participate with the permission of the director, seniors only).

Students who do not maintain class enrollment or other "good standing" requirements will not be allowed to participate in spring trips.
